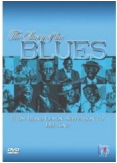

Defining the blues is a simple task: a basic I-IV-V chord progression laid over 12-bar framework, however the blues have evolved from African-American field hollers through rough hewn rural heavyweights such as Blind Lemon Jefferson to the immaculate guitar excursions of BB King.

The Story of the Blues traces the four principal traditions of blues music; Blues Form Country Blues - Country Blues - Urban Blues - Electric Blues and it's significant contribution to the development of jazz, rock music and country western music.
