Josef Rejcha's numerous compositions span a variety of genres. - Rejcha extensively explored the sound qualities of the string instruments, working with expressive melodies and colourful instrumentation. - His concertos for violin, violin duet, violoncello and violin with violoncello were extraordinarily popular in his day. - Rejcha had a fundamental influence on the early works of two composers - his nephew Antonin Rejcha (1767-1836), theorist and later professor at Paris Conservatory, and Ludwig van Beethoven. --- supraphon.com

The Czechian Josef Rejcha (Joseph Reicha) 1752-1795 lived in Bonn (Germany) and has had an excellent Orchestra there! Beethoven has spendt his younger days in the Orchestra of Reicha.- Finally in Vienna he has often told to the Vienna audience, that he has heard there some excellent music.
