

Indeed, the variety of concert programs Valery has prepared with his favorite Classic Jazz Ensemble is hard to match.

Despite any changes in the line-up of musicians, you will recognize the signature sound of both the Ensemble and Valery Kiselyov himself as soon as the music starts playing. While preparing programs dedicated to his icons Benny Goodman or Duke Ellington, Valery does not attempt to simulate their performance.
