At least half of the tracks on this album were major hits in this part of the world. These are all catchy tunes, with good production, and excellent mature female vocals. The music is probably described as pop, but it does have a Spanish edge on many songs, and perhaps adult conteporary may be a better description. Don't try to extract deep meaning from the lyrics though - they are simple, but not necessarily corny. "What's a Woman?" is the track that makes the album for me - a sad tune with exceptionally good lyrics about the support that a man and a woman need from each other.
